INTRODUCTORY CLASS

In the Introductory Class, students are introduced to Japanese starting with the alphabet. This includes hiragana, katakana, double consonants, long vowels and other foundation level elements.

In addition, students will gradually become comfortable with reading, writing, speaking and listening skills.

INTERMEDIATE CLASS

In the intermediate class, students practice conversation and reading things such as newspapers and long articles. A teacher is available to answer questions regarding written Japanese, and by doing exercises, students can practice become confident using phrases.

A lot of difficult 'Kanji' come up when reading, so emphasis is placed on developing an understanding of common expressions. Students also talk about culture differences and life in Japan. The intermediate class is a wonderful place for enjoyable conversation and sharing interests that the students deeply cherish.

In Introductory Class, students study Japanese using a variety of materials such as books, printouts and free conversation. It is approximately level N3 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT).
